

SUBJECT: Creaking Sound When Operating Clutch Pedal

INTRODUCTION:

NOTE: This bulletin replaces prior / related TSB 12-190-15R dated 3/25/2016.

A new brake/clutch pedal bracket assembly has been developed with increased rigidity to address customer concerns of a creaking sound heard when operating the clutch pedal. This condition does not indicate the presence of any current operational issue with the pedal assembly, clutch hydraulic system, clutch assembly or, serve as a precursor to any future concerns. The enhanced pedal bracket design incorporates an extended flange length along with additional welding to increase rigidity and reduce the possibility of the creaking sound. The repair involves replacement of the brake / clutch pedal assembly.





SERVICE PROCEDURE / INFORMATION

Once the sound has been verified, attach a chassis ear to the toe board / bulkhead in the location circled in the illustration below then operate the clutch pedal.



If the sound is confirmed to be originating from that location, replace the brake / clutch pedal assembly with the new part from the table above. Follow the procedure in the applicable Service Manual for replacing the pedal assembly including the additional critical points listed below:

IMPORTANT:

- **ALWAYS** use new clevis pins when attaching the brake pedal apply rod and the clutch pedal push rod.
- After the installation is complete, **ALWAYS** confirm both clutch switches and the stop light switch are properly adjusted following the procedures in the applicable Service Manual.
